WHAT'S NEW?

Of the Group of 40 cats / kittens outside that we have been bringing in since last fall (see press release & media coverage for details), we have brought in and provided vet care to 35 kitties so far..... There are only about three or four left outside from this group.

Hungry and Homeless Cat Rescue volunteers have done all we can do to help these kitties. We have brought them inside, spayed / neutered them, provided vet care, food and shelter for these kitties. We have prevented thousands of cats being born homeless outside from one mother alone - see Cat Over-Population - Stanford Cat Network

CAT HEALTH TIP - WHAT IS FIV?

FIV, or Feline Immunodeficiency Virus, is basically a compromised immune system for cats. There are many myths concerning FIV. No, it is not transferable to humans or any other animals. It is transmitted to other cats through large quantities of blood or saliva being exchanged, usually through fighting and biting. Incidentally, of all the cats we have brought inside who were sharing food and sharing sleeping quarters with other cats outside, only one cat in the group had FIV, but the others did not. FIV is not a death sentence. If a cat is fed good quality food, and provided with a healthy non-clumping litter, and an ample source of fresh water, a cat with FIV can live as long and healthy a life as any other cat. Please don't dismiss adopting a cat because it has FIV. Read more.
